Bicycle Permission

Dear Parents,

Your child has requested permission to ride his/her bicycle to school. The decision for granting this request is yours. All we ask is that you consider all the responsibilities that must be assumed by your child while driving on the roads from your home to the school and then use your best judgment in deciding whether he/she is old enough and capable of understanding the role and responsibility of a bicycle driver in traffic. With your permission, we will permit your child to drive his/her bicycle to school so long as the following regulations are observed:

1. A permission slip signed by the parents or guardian is presented to the school office.
2. Students should not arrive at school before 8:45 a.m.
3. Upon arrival at school, bicycles are parked in the designated bicycle parking area and remain there until dismissal.
4. Bicyclists should ride safely and follow the bicycle laws as set forth by the State of Pennsylvania. All bicyclists under the age of 12 are required by law to wear a helmet. Bicyclists should not travel on neighborhood yards. When coming up the path to the school, walkers should be given the right of way.
5. The bicyclist should come directly to school and go directly home from school unless written permission is given to do otherwise.
6. It is understood that bicycle privileges may be withdrawn at any time because of regulation infractions.
